Purpose of data collection, processing or use (No 4)

The purpose of the company is principally:

Development, manufacturing and sale of circuit board based system solutions for power distribution boards, displays and control panels, electronic controls (ICCS), electro-mechanical components in press-fit technology or SKEDD direct plug-in technology.

The company collects, processes and uses person-related data exclusively to fulfil or prepare contracts, meet legal requirements or by agreement with those affected.

Groups of individuals affected and the data or data categories to which they relate (No 5)

The groups of individuals affected are:

- current staff,
- former staff,
- job applicants,
- prospective customers,
- customers,
- suppliers,
- service providers
- and other business partners.

The data relating to these include all person-related data necessary to carry out the respective purposes.



Potential recipients during data transmission (No 6)

The potential recipients of person-related data transmitted are

- public bodies, if a legal requirement applies,
- customers, service providers and other business partners insofar as required in order to fulfil the respective purposes, and a legal provision allows or requires this, or the individual affected has agreed.
- No further transfer of person-related data is foreseen and none will therefore take place.

Deadlines for the deletion of the data (No 7)

The deletion of person-related data is carried out in accordance with the relevant legal or contractual regulations for data deletion, taking into account legal or contractual retention requirements.

The deletion of person-related data which are not subject to any legal or contractual requirements for retention or deletion is carried out immediately after they become unnecessary for the fulfilment of the relevant purpose.

Planned data transmission to third countries (No 8)

If data transmission to third countries is required, this will only be done at the conclusion or to fulfil contracts insofar as the legitimate interest of the individuals affected does not prevent it. In the consideration of the interests of the individuals affected and the contractual parties, a strict standard will always be used to the benefit of the individuals affected
